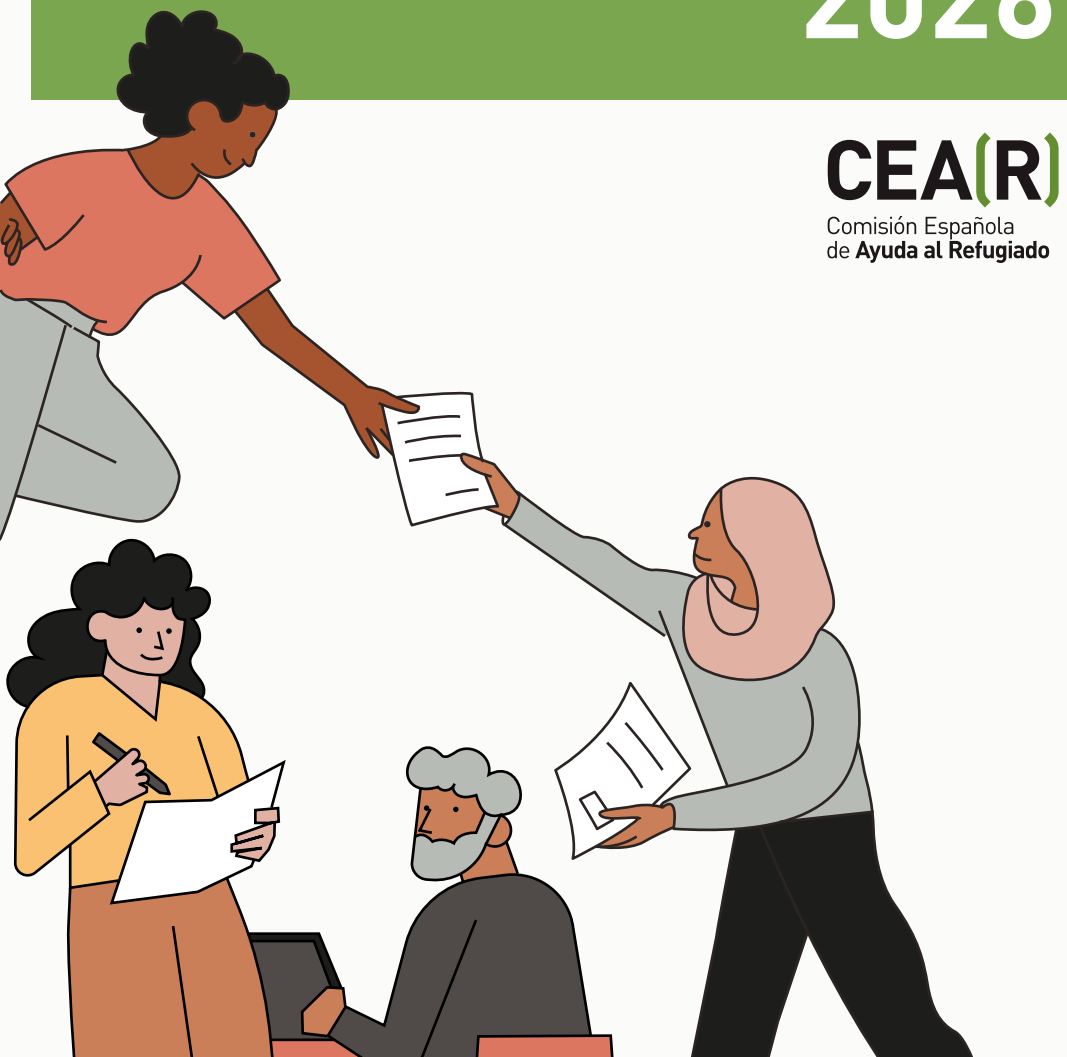




# SPECIAL REGULARISATION PROCESS

## WHO CAN APPLY?



- **International protection applicants** who formalised, registered or presented their application request for this process **before 1st January 2026**
- **Foreign persons of irregular status** who came to Spain **before 1st January 2026**

## WHO CANNOT APPLY?

- **Beneficiaries of temporary protection** or persons who have been beneficiaries in the past.
- **Persons whose residence or stay has been authorised** or whose authorisation is being processed (requested, renewed, extended or modified)

## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1 **Uninterrupted stay of 5 months** in Spain at the time of the application
- 2 **The applicant's residence or stay in Spain has not been authorised** and these are not currently being requested, extended, renewed or modified
- 3 **The applicant does not have a criminal record** in Spain or in the countries where the applicant has resided over the last 5 years
- 4 **The applicant does not present a threat** to public order, national security or public health
- 5 **The applicant does not appear as refusible** in the countries with which Spain has signed an agreement
- 6 **The applicant is not subject to a no-return commitment**
- 7 **Payment of the fee** corresponding to the authorisation of residence due to social ties (€38.28)



# GENERAL DOCUMENTATION



- ✓ **Passport of nationality, travel document or registration certificate** (in force or expired)
- ✓ **Criminal record certificate from the country/countries of residence of the last 5 years** (prior to entry into Spain), duly **legalised and translated** where appropriate
- ✓ **Documentation attesting to the fact that the applicant has been in Spain for 5 months** (local residency registration certificate or “empadronamiento”, medical reports, invoices...)
- ✓ **Receipt of payment** of the corresponding fee “[tasa 052](#)” (mark option 2.3.1)



## FOR INTERNATIONAL PROTECTION APPLICANTS

- ✓ [Form EX31](#)
- ✓ **Documentation attesting to the fact that the applicant applied for international protection before 1st January 2026** (red card, application receipt, declaration of intention)

## FOR FOREIGN PERSONS

- ✓ [Form EX32](#)
- ✓ **Documentation attesting to the fact that the applicant arrived in Spain before 1st January 2026**
- ✓ *Documentation attesting to any of the following circumstances:*
  - **Having worked (or having had the intention to work)** for an employer or as a self-employed person (offer of one or various employment contracts featuring a **duration or more than 90 days** or responsible declaration of self-employment).
  - **Cohabitation with children** who are in school, adults who are disabled or persons who are **first-degree ancestors**
  - [Social vulnerability certificate](#) issued by Social Services or Collaborating Bodies for Immigration Affairs

# PROCESS



<b>PRESENTATION PERIOD</b>	<b>Between 16th April 2026 and 30th June 2026</b>
<b>PLACE OF PRESENTATION</b>	<b>In person with prior appointment</b> ( <a href="#">via Web</a> or 060) at Immigration Offices, Social Security Offices, Post Offices or <b>Official Procedures Website</b> ("Sede electronica")
<b>COMMUNICATION OF COMMENCEMENT OF PROCESS</b>	The applicant's residence and employment shall be temporarily authorised
<b>DECISION</b>	<b>within 3 months</b>

## IF THE APPLICATION IS APPROVED



**Authorisation of residence and employment for a period of one year**



**Issue of the TIE (Foreign Resident Card) one month after the application is approved** (attesting to having presented a renunciation of any international protection application, where appropriate)

## FAMILY MEMBERS LIVING WITH THE APPLICANT IN QUESTION

- Children of minority age or disabled adults who cannot meet their own needs

Simultaneous application for:

- [Authorisation of residence for a foreign accompanying minor born in Spain](#) (exemption from the six-month period as of birth)
- [Authorisation of residence for a foreign accompanying minor not born in Spain](#) (requirement of stay of 5 months and exemption from the economic resources and appropriate housing requirement)

- Registered spouse or partner and first-degree ancestors

- Simultaneous application for regularisation
